5. DIPLOMA IN GENERAL NURSING AND MIDWIFERY

This educational programme enables the students to acquire adequate knowledge and skill to give efficient nursing care. The three year course is conducted as per the syllabus prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council . Diploma is awarded by the Kerala Nurse sand Midwives Council after successful completion of the course.

6. NUMBER OF SEATS

This school has an annual intake of 40 students.

7. GENERAL OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE

1. The candidate on completion of this course will be able to:
 - a. Assess the nursing need of clients from birth to death.
 - b. Plan and carry out appropriate action to meet nursing needs.
 - c. Provide effective nursing care to maintain best possible level of health in all aspects.
 - d. Promote self care in people under their care.
 - e. Apply problem solving techniques in nursing practice.
 - f. Evaluate effectiveness of nursing care.
2. Apply knowledge from the humanities, biological and behavioral sciences in functioning as a nurse.
3. Function effectively with members of the health team and community applying the knowledge of human relations and communication skill in her work.
4. Participate as member of the health team in delivery of curative, preventive, promotive and rehabilitative health care services.
5. Demonstrate use of ethical values in their personal and professional life.
6. Demonstrate interest in activities of professional organization.
7. Recognize the need for continuing education for professional development.
8. Demonstrate basic skills in teaching patients and giving nursing care to them.
9. Demonstrate basic skills in administration and leadership while working with other members of health team and community.
10. Assist in research activities.

8. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

1. **Academic:-** Higher Secondary examination (Plus Two) Pass with an aggregate of 70% marks. Preference will be given to candidate with Biology, Physics & Chemistry. In the absence of science group, any group with an aggregate of 70% mark will be considered.

2. **Age:-**The candidate should be 17 years of age and should not be more than 35 years.

Eligibility certificate:- Candidate can be a resident of any state in India. Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from outside the state of Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalency of qualifying examination from Board of Kerala. This should be furnished at the time of interview for admission.

For foreign nationals

- The entry qualification equivalency i.e., 12th standard will be obtained by Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi.

3. Reservation

- a) For disabled candidates: 3% disability reservation to be considered with a disability of loco motor to the tune of 40% to 50% of the lower extremity.
 - b) 10% is reserved for SC/ST candidates.
 - c) Any other quotas as per the State Govt. under the reservation policy.
4. Admission of students shall be once in a year.
 5. Students shall be medically fit.

9. HOW TO APPLY

The application form fee Rs. 250 (Two Hundred and Fifty Only) may be transferred through NEFT/RTGS

1. The application forms should be completed carefully, furnishing the entire information called for. Late and incomplete applications form will be summarily rejected.
2. Applicants should fill their details carefully and confirm the submission. A printout of the confirmation page has to taken and kept by the applicant for future reference. Online submission of application ends on 7/7/2024.

10. SELECTION

1. Admission to Diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery will be made on merit as assessed on the basis of the total marks secured by the candidates for the Part III Optional Subjects at the Plus two/equivalent examination and an interview.
2. After verification of certificates the applied Candidates will be called for an interview by selection committee and selected candidates list will be prepared by the Committee. Candidates should produce all original certificates and documents for verification at the time of interview. The date and venue of interview will be intimated later.

The selection committee will consist of

- (1) Council Nominee
- (2) Director of the institution
- (3) Medical Superintendent
- (4) Chief Nursing Officer
- (5) Principal of the School of Nursing

The selected candidates list will be published by the principal, School of Nursing on the next day of interview at 8 am.

11. ADMISSION

1. The selected candidates will be informed of the date and time of admission.
2. The student shall pay the full fees of first year course, at the time of admission.
3. Fees once paid will not be refunded.
4. Second year onwards fee is to be paid in advance, in two installments, in the month of September and March.
5. The students are expected to confirm the seats by the submission of following certificates at the time of admission.

12. ANTIRAGGING

Ragging is AN OFFENCE PUNISHABLE UNDER LAW.

13. CONCESSION

Selected candidates are eligible for educational concession/scholarship/grants/admissible for SC/ST/OEC candidates. Hostel facility will be provided to candidates, if required.

14. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

Those who leave the course after the last date for admission will be required to pay the entire tuition fee of the course as liquidated damages.

15. GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

- Immediately after entering the school, the students shall make themselves acquainted with all the rules of the institution.
- The students are not allowed to accept gift of any kind from the patients or patient's relatives.
- All the students should wear uniform during duty hours as per the guidelines of the institution.
- The students shall be elegant in appearance and polite in behaviour and courteous in dealing with superiors, colleagues as well as patients.

- The students shall be punctual in their attendance for classes and other duties. A minimum of 80% attendance in theory classes and 100% clinical attendance for each subjects is necessary to appear for the examination.
- The students are expected to follow the timetable and observe order and silence at the school, Hospital and its premises.
- The students shall be willing to carryout any work allotted to them, while on duty, under the direct supervision of the ward sister in charge and tutors.
- Disciplinary action will be taken for disobedience, dishonesty, indifference, negligence etc. At any time during the course, the students will be subject to dismissal for serious misconduct or repeated neglect of duties.
